**Giving Tree Celebration** (Purpose: Charity support) –  
November/December

Each year, the Chamber collects gifts for needy individuals that are served by our Non-profit members. Tags are made and distributed to local businesses throughout the community. Patrons of those businesses purchase gifts based on the Christmas wishes on the tags. Around 1,200 gifts were collected in 2023.

**Holiday Social** (Purpose: Social gathering for members) – December

An evening of cheer to celebrate the holiday season! It features dinner and a cash bar along with raffle items and entertainment. The Holiday Social can also be used as a holiday party for smaller companies who may not have the budget for an end-of-year party.



**Legislative Breakfast** (Purpose: Educational Event) – Multiple times per year



The Legislative Breakfast is a new event created by the Legislative and Economic Development Committee. The goal of the Legislative Breakfast is to bring local legislators closer to the communities that they serve and discuss workforce development within those communities. Legislators from the local and state levels are both brought in to talk at these events.
