




#### Community Champion Awards (Purpose: Community Recognition) - January




<u>Giving Tree Celebration</u> (Purpose: Charity support) – November/*December*

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The Legislative Breakfast is a new event created by the Legislative and Economic Development Committee. The goal of the Legislative Breakfast is to bring local legislators

closer to the communities that they serve and discuss workforce development within those communities. Legislators from the local and state levels are both brought in to talk at these events.

<u>Women's Leadership Roundtable</u> (Purpose: Networking and Education)- 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of every month

Networking meetings focused on women in business. Each meeting will include time for short introductions by the participants followed by a half-hour interactive educational presentation. Meetings will be facilitated virtually by Dr. Ann Gatty. Quarterly mixers at a local business.









**Business After Hours** (Purpose: Networking) – *Monthly*
